



STEPS TO GETTING A TEXAS DRIVER'S LICENSE (ADULTS 18+)

1

STEP ONE • COMPLETE DRIVER'S EDUCATION

(Another way to get your Learner's permit)

- Ages 18–24 must take a 6-Hour Adult Driver's Ed course
- Ages 25+ are encouraged to take the ADE to skip the Knowledge Test

STEP TWO • COMPLETE IMPACT TEXAS DRIVERS (ITD)

- ITYD for ages 18–24 online (<https://impacttexasdrivers.dps.texas.gov/>)
- ITAD for ages 25+ online (<https://impacttexasdrivers.dps.texas.gov/itad/>)
- Must be completed before the driving test

STEP THREE • GATHER REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- Proof of identity, residency, and citizenship
- Social Security Number
- Certificates of course completion

STEP FOUR • VISIT A TEXAS DPS OFFICE

- Submit DL-14A application
- Provide biometric data and photo
- Pay Driver's License Application Fee- \$33

STEP FIVE • PASS REQUIRED EXAMS

- Vision Test
- Written knowledge test for 25+ (may be waived)
- Driving Skills Test

STEP SIX • RECEIVE YOUR LICENSE

- Temporary paper license issued
- Official license mailed within 2–3 weeks

Exemption from Written Test for Adults 25+:

If you complete an approved Adult Driver Education course at Nova Driving School and the Impact Texas Adult Drivers (ITAD) course (a free, one-hour video), you can be **exempted from the written knowledge test.**
