



STEPS TO GETTING A TEXAS DRIVER'S LICENSE (TEENS AGES 15-17)

STEP ONE • COMPLETE 24-HOUR DRIVER EDUCATION CLASS

- Minimum age: 14
- Choose Live Instructor or Parent-supervised Self-Study
- Courses available Online

STEP TWO • APPLY FOR A LEARNER'S LICENSE (PERMIT)

- Minimum age: 15 / Pass written exam after 6 classroom hrs are complete
- Submit required documents, pass vision test, and pay fees to DPS:
 - Refer to DPS website for details

STEP THREE • COMPLETE BEHIND-THE-WHEEL TRAINING

- Hold permit for at least 6 months
- Complete w/ Driving Instructor: 7 hrs driving instruction + 7 hrs observation
- Complete additional 30 hours of supervised driving (10 at night)
- Receive Completion certificate (DE-964)

STEP FOUR • COMPLETE THE (ITTD) PROGRAM

- <https://impacttexasdrivers.dps.texas.gov/ittd/>
- Watch 2-hour ITTD video
- Must be completed within 90 days of driving test

STEP FIVE • APPLY FOR A PROVISIONAL LICENSE

- Minimum age: 16 to Pass Driving Test at DPS or approved Test Provider
- Submit required documents and pay fees to DPS:
 - Refer to DPS website for details
- Refer to DPS website for Provisional License restrictions

STEP SIX • UPGRADE TO FULL LICENSE AT AGE 18

- Reapply as adult license holder
- Restrictions lifted
